Day 1

Day 3

Full Scottish Breakfast.

Depart for a journey up to Fort William area. Make a stop at the Bo'ness Motor Museum where you can see Ron Weasley's Ford Anglia or visit the Scottish Owl Centre to say hello to Hedwig's friends and other exotic owl species.

Continue north travelling across Rannoch Moor the place where Death Eaters board the train in the movie *Harry Potter and The Deathly Hallows: Part 1*.

Glencoe is packed full of history, beautiful wildlife & geology as well as being one of the film locations for the Harry Potter Films amongst others. For generations, the Clachaig Inn has been a handy stop for weary walkers traversing the glen, but it also happens to be a filming location for Hagrid's Hut in the third movie installment, *Harry Potter and the Prisoner of Azkaban*.

Check into your accommodation for overnight.

Day 4

Full Scottish Breakfast.

Today, you will board the Hogwart's Express – otherwise known as the Jacobite Steam Train.

Some say that the West Highland Line is the greatest rail journey in the world. In the summer, the Jacobite Steam train travels along the route in addition to the regular trains. The steam train had a starring role as the *Hogwarts Express taking Harry from platform 9 ¾ all the way to Hogwarts*. Take the journey over the magnificent Glenfinnan Viaduct, whilst enjoying views of Loch Shiel from your window, another key location in the films. The train stops in Mallaig for about 90 minutes & you are free to disembark to visit this pretty Fishing village and enjoy some traditional Fish n' Chips.

Return to Fort William station about 4pm.

Day 5

Full Scottish Breakfast & check out of your hotel. Depending on your flight, there are options for other stops included in the Harry Potter films including to Steall Falls which is where in The Goblet of Fire, Harry faces down a Hungarian Horntail dragon in the Triwizard Tournament.

Return to Edinburgh airport for your flight home.
