Day 1 Arrival

Arrive into Edinburgh or Glasgow Airports. Be met by your driver who will escort you in comfort down to the Scottish Borders for a two night stay in **Thirlestane Castle**, historic home of the Maitland family.

Dinner & overnight in the Castle.

Day 2 Scottish Borders

After breakfast, meet with one of the Estate Gamekeepers and take walk up onto the Moors. Hear the wildlife and learn how this land is being preserved for future generations. Whilst this is a walk, a Landrover can also be on hand.

In the afternoon, take a bespoke tour to visit some of the Scottish Borders highlights.

In the evening back at the Castle, take part in a tutored Whisky Tasting with a selection of regional whiskies, exploring the differences with each and learning about the production of Scotland's favourite tipple.

Day 3 Fort William

After breakfast, you will be met by your driver who will drive you north towards Fort William on the West Coast. Stops could include Stirling Castle or the Wallace Monument.

Meet the train at Crianlarich which you will board & enjoy a scenic journey up onto Rannoch Moor. Disembark at Corroul where you will be met by the Estate's Landrovers and driven to **Corroul Lodge**. You will be welcomed with coffee or wee dram and settle into your room – each of which is individually styled and includes every comfort that you might wish for.



The Lodge is fully catered and once you have settled into your room for the evening, dinner will be served.

Day 4 Corroul Estate

After breakfast, enjoy a taster of what Corroul Estate has to offer – whether you are keen hill-walkers, love to fish or want to spend time canoeing on Loch Ossian. Here are just a few thoughts for your full day here.

Climb aboard one of the Land Rover Defenders and head out to explore the incredible Corroul Estate.

Day 5 Corroul – Inverness

After breakfast, enjoy a morning's activities before your driver returns to meet you and take you out of this stunning Glen and back to the main road to drive you North towards Inverness. Heading north, you will follow the Great Glen, a fantastic Glen which follows a geological fault known as the Great Glen. The Lochs are all linked by the Caledonian Canal and includes Loch Ness. Travelling up the south side of Loch Ness, you will reach the beautiful **Aldourie Castle**.

It has been extensively renovated recently and is now only let on an exclusive basis.

Dinner & overnight.

Day 6 Inverness & beyond

Enjoy a day exploring this area and the programme can be designed to take into consideration the parties interests. Visits could include Culloden Moor, Cawdor Castle or Fort George. Or take a boat trip out onto the Moray Firth to watch wildlife and hopefully see the Moray Firth Dolphins. For Outlander fans, there are options to visit some of the many special locations in which the series was filmed.



Or take a day trip across to the Speyside Whisky Trail for a Whisky Tour of the many famous Speyside distilleries. Enjoy lunch in one of them or in a local restaurant with an exceptional whisky bar!

Return to **Aldourie Castle** for dinner and overnight.

Day 7 Departure

After breakfast, you will be met by your driver and taken to the Airport – either Inverness, Aberdeen, Edinburgh or Glasgow.
